

EMPLOYEE JOB ACTIONS
(Unauthorized Employee Absences)

The school board is committed to uphold the law of the State of New Hampshire that any strike, job action or withholding of services by a public employee is illegal.

Any employee of the Board who engages in a strike, job action, withholds services, absents himself without leave or authorization, or declines to perform his/her duties and responsibilities will be acting contrary to the law of the state.

Any employee who so acts will:

1. Suffer a deduction in salary for every day s/he is absent from work.
2. Have an official reprimand placed in his/her permanent record.
3. At the discretion of the school board, be subject to immediate discharge for violating state law.
