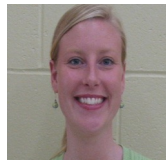
Coming Soon

Physical Education Teacher

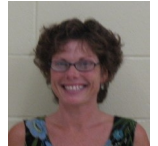
Hi, my name is Joan Tinker. I came to Bow as a veteran teacher
