These forms are only issued to [Juniors](#) and [Seniors](#). Parking Permits are not issued to Freshmen and Sophomores, nor are they permitted to arrive late, leave early, or leave campus during the school day at any time (excluding medical and other appointments). Sophomores are only permitted to park in the dirt lot on White Rock Hill Rd., across from the basketball courts.

Juniors and Seniors applying for Parking Permits must also submit their signed Early Release/Late Arrival forms in order to receive a parking permit.

**Seniors will be issued parking permits during the week of Aug. 22-26.
Juniors will be issued parking permits on a 'first come, first served' basis, beginning Monday Aug. 29.**

Students must have a NH driver's license and vehicle registration (of the car they will be driving) with them when submitting a parking permit form.
